- <u>Awarded Title</u>: It has been specified that only students under the new GHS regulations will be awarded a title with a German translation.
- Doctoral Agreement, specialization title: It has been specified that the extended list of doctoral degree specializations in KSL is only available to students under the old GHS regulations. Students under the new regulations can choose from the specializations in the drop-down list on the Doctoral Agreement. Please note that the final decision regarding the acceptance of a doctoral degree specialization will be made jointly by the GHS Office and the GHS Steering Board, based on the type of master's degree held by the candidate.
